From I-25: Exit at Harmony Road in Fort Collins. Use exit # 265. Go west for about four miles. Turn left on Lemay. Go south for one block. Turn right at the first street (not business entrances). There is a light at that intersection. The Church is on your left. Go past it and turn into the entrance on your left. You will go around to the back (south) side of the building.

No Food or Drink will be allowed in the gym. We will not have a concession stand. Plan to bring your own food, or there are numerous fast food options close to the contest venue. Tables and chairs will be set up outside the gym to eat.

Maddie's Kettle Corn will be available for purchase at the contest.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entry deadline: online entries must be submitted by March 10.
- Payments must be received by March 19. Any payment not received by March 19 will result in the contestant being dropped from the contest. You may hand your payment to Ann Durkin at the March 19th contest.
- No refunds will be provided.
- All team entries must be sent in by director with correct fee and a list of names, ages, and birthdays. Include waivers from individual entry.
- Council Tree Covenant Church and contest directors are NOT responsible for accidents, injuries, or lost items.
- No flash pictures allowed during competition.
- Video tape only your own twirler or group.
- When determining level to enter, all competitive wins, regardless of organization, must be counted. Totals are as follows:

Nov.- Never won a competitive 1st place in that event. (competitive means at least 2 people in the event.)

Beg.- Less than 5 competitive wins in that event.

Intermediate- Less than 10 competitive wins. Advanced- 10 or more competitive wins.

- Each contestant entering individual events will receive a program at the door contest day.

- Pre Solo, Flag, Hoop, Ribbon, Rifle- 1:00
- Show Twirl, 1:30-2:30
- Trios, Dance Twirl Teams, Show Twirl Teams 2:00-3:00
- Twirl Teams, 3:00-4:00
